



OUR SEARCH PROCESS

TIMETABLE

We are using a “two step” process in order to both cast the widest net possible in identifying candidates, and to limit the more rigorous application to only those that we assess as viable candidates.

The Dean Search Committee (DSC) will review and recommend candidates at each stage of the process. The final selection will be made by Bishop Marc Andrus, with approval by the Board of Trustees. The timetable is as follows, and is subject to adjustment based on circumstances:

2009	July 1	Open nominations
	August 1	Publish the profile
	October 1	Preliminary applications due
	October 15	Candidates will be invited to continue in the process and to complete the final application
	November 30	Final applications due
2010	January-February	Finalists selected
	March-May	Visits with finalists
	May 23	Recommended candidates presented to Bishop Marc by Pentecost
	June	Bishop Marc nominates and Board of Trustees approve
	Summer	Relocation time
	September 2010	Michaelmas Installation (Sep 29th)
